- Acquire skills needed for jobs being trained and their relation to other positions within the work environment.
- Choreograph the daily schedule by taking into consideration staff to student ratio, skill being taught, goal of the activity and the level of independence amongst students.
- Develop supplemental materials related to job training.
- Incorporate technology into instructional methods.
- Differentiate instructional methods based on individual learning styles of the students.
- Develop assessment tools to measure student progress in all areas of the training program.
- Oversee and determine the role of Student Support Specialists in daily lessons and activities.
- Develop materials for tutors to utilize when working with a student.
- Develop the structure and assessment tools for Career Sampling Sessions.
- Participate in the development and execution of initial interviews and assessments of applicants.
- Enforce Erskine Green Training Institute (EGTI) policies.
- Communicate and collaborate with nurse, community living support, and overnight support.
- Assist with research studies.
- Communicate with EGTI staff to determine immediate coverage should an emergency occur or immediate need transpire after training hours.
- Make arrangements in the event of an absence.
- Assist with graduation ceremonies.
- Assist with move-in and move-out days.

- Participate in new student orientation.
- Communicate and collaborate with professionals in the hospitality, food service, and healthcare settings.
- Communicate and collaborate with EGTI director and additional foundation staff.
- Communicate and collaborate with the Muncie community.
- Communicate with parents/guardians of students.
